JAY ANDRIJIĆ, South Perith
Jay proved he was on his way to the top of the tennis world by taking out the Gallipoli Youth Cup in Ipswich this year. The 15-year-old didn't stop there, winning the singles and doubles titles in the two Queensland Junior Winter Internationals, his fourth and fifth titles in a row.



DANIELLE BECROFT, Londonderry
A national mountain bike champion, Danielle has continued to impress on the bike as the year's have gone by. After winning the Perith Press Junior Sports Star award in 2008, she is back after becoming national champion in the under-17 4X and open pump categories. She then went on to finished fourth in the Canadian pro women's downhill mountain bike race.
