CARLILE Swimming proved to be the strongest club at the second Nutrition Station Open Water Swim at the Sydney International Regatta Centre on Saturday.

Carlile took out the club point score category from Campbelltown and the University of NSW, while Cormack Guthrie (Sea's The Limit) won the 5km men's event with Matthew Robinson (Carlile) and Robert Warcaba (Campbelltown) rounding out the placings.

Emily Doyle (Warringah Aquatic) was the quickest woman over 5km, ahead of Emma Gillingham (Woden Valley) and Claudia Frykberg (COSAC).

More than \$4500 in prize-money was up for grabs as clubs from all over the state turned out for the 5km event and 2.5km races.

Over the shorter distance Campbelltown's Gabriel Wilczak won the boys division with Kimberley Doyle (Warringah Aquatic) too strong in the girls category.

It was a successful day in an event that is set to continue to grow according to race organiser Alan Bentley.

"We're thrilled with the calibre and number of swimmers we had," he said.
