Club Uniform Policy

Version 1.0

In order to bring consistency to how our club uniform is worn by its athletes, the committee have developed this policy document. It outlines when each of the various uniform items can and /or must be worn.

If you have any questions in relation to anything in this document, please raise it with one of the committee members.

<p>Standard - Black</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cap - Shirt - Club Singlet 	<p>Cap must be worn by everyone at targeted meets, including Metropolitan, State and National representative swimmers</p> <p>First cap is provided to swimmers free and any replacements are funded by families</p> <p>Club shirts or singlets to be worn at targeted meets.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If an athlete is new to the club and hasn't had time to purchase a club shirt or singlet before their first target meet / club event, then black t-shirt or polo is to be worn <p>All shirts and singlets are funded by families and are available for purchase from the club's uniform officer</p>
<p>Metropolitan (Teal) and State (Silver) Representative</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cap - Shirt - Open Water Singlet 	<p>Caps and shirts must be worn at Metropolitan and / or State meets</p> <p>Caps can be worn at any other meets, except club targeted meets where standard black cap is worn, providing that the athlete is currently qualified at that level.</p> <p>Shirts can be worn at any meet, including club targeted meets, providing that the athlete is currently qualified at that level.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A club cap must be worn, and this can be a representative cap (unless it is a club target meet, then the club black cap must be worn) <p>Metropolitan representative swimmers have a cap branded with 'Representative'</p> <p>State representative swimmers have a cap branded with 'State Representative'</p> <p>Caps and Shirts only to be worn when representing the club</p> <p>Replacements will be funded by the club where the athlete has outgrown them, providing they are currently qualified at that level</p> <p>Replacements are to be funded by family when the item is lost or damaged</p>

<p>National Representative - White</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cap - Shirt - Open Water Singlet 	<p>Caps and shirts must be worn at National meets</p> <p>Caps can be worn at any other meets, except club targeted meets where standard black cap is worn, providing that the athlete is currently qualified at that level.</p> <p>Shirts can be worn at any meets, including club targeted meets, providing that the athlete is currently qualified at that level.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A club cap must be worn, and this can be a representative cap (unless it is a club target meet, then the club black cap must be worn) <p>Caps and shirts are personalised with the athlete's name</p> <p>Caps and shirts are only to be worn when representing the club</p> <p>Replacements will be funded by the club where the athlete has outgrown them, providing they are currently qualified at that level</p> <p>Replacements are to be funded by family when the item is lost or damaged</p>
<p>Relay teams</p>	<p>Black club cap is to be worn at target meets</p> <p>Representative / State / National caps can worn if all members of the team have individual qualification times</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If not all relay swimmers have individual qualification times, then the club black cap is to be worn
<p>Club Captains</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Embroidered Shirts - Bars 	<p>Presented with a new club shirt</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Branded with name, club captain and year <p>If they are club captain again, they are given the option of either</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. a new shirt (as above) or 2. add year to existing shirt
<p>Committee Members</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Standard Black Polo 	<p>These are self-funded</p> <p>Embroidered with 'Committee Member' to be paid for by the club</p>
